Total Call Volume and Response Times









Sewer Feasibility Study

What and Why?

- Majority of flow goes through ATI lift station
- Upgrades in 2018 max future capacity
- Industrial growth flows highly variable
- Residential growth future
- Evaluate how to get wastewater to the treatment plant in the future
- More accessible infrastructure








Sewer Feasibility Study – Alternatives



Sewer Feasibility Study – Recommended Alternatives

5A and 5B – One pump station, part force main, part pumped. Future connection point east of I-5.

1B and 1A – One pump station, all pumped. More difficult to connect future flows.

Route C – not accessible


